### **Robertson and Delsing re-elected chair and vice chair of Nebraska Wheat Board**

Brent Robertson of Elsie and Bob Delsing of Hemingford were re-elected chair and vice chair of the Nebraska Wheat Board (NWB) during the board's most recent meeting. Both Robertson and Delsing served in their respective positions during fiscal years 2016-2017 and 2017-2018.

Robertson is in his third term as the District 7 (at-large) director for NWB. He and his wife Amy raise irrigated and dryland wheat and corn in Perkins, Chase and Lincoln counties. He represents NWB on the Wheat Foods Council (WFC), has served as the WFC president, and currently represents NWB on the board of directors for U.S. Wheat Associates (USW).

Delsing currently farms with his son Scott in Dawes and Box Butte counties on the land homesteaded by their ancestors. Delsing is completing his first term as the District 1 director for NWB. He currently represents NWB on the board of directors for USW and also sits on the USW long range planning committee.

"The re-election of Brent and Bob is a testament to their efforts to support the wheat industry and the faith the board has in the work they're doing," said Royce Schaneman, NWB executive director. "I look forward to continuing to work with them this fiscal year."

Members of the Board of Directors are appointed by the governor to serve five-year terms. The chairman and vice chairman are elected by the board during the first meeting of a new fiscal year.

The Nebraska Wheat Board administers the check-off of 0.4% of net value of wheat marketed in Nebraska at the point of first sale. The board invests the funds in programs of international and domestic market development and improvement, policy development, research, promotion, and education.
