Nebraska Wheat Board Announces February Meeting

Lincoln, Neb.— The Nebraska Wheat Board (NWB) will hold its next meeting Wednesday, February 12 in Lincoln, Neb. The meeting will take place at the Nebraska Cattlemen Office, 4611 Discovery Drive, in Lincoln, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

During the business meeting, the NWB board will conduct a first reading of funding proposals for fiscal year 2020-2021. The meeting will also include reports from members on committee activities as well as updates from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and Nebraska Wheat Growers Association. The board will also review contractor reports, determine travel and participation in upcoming meetings and events. The public is welcome to attend any open portion of the meeting. On Thursday, February 13, the Nebraska Wheat Board members will be participating in their annual Bake and Take educational event.
