SIouxLAND MOST POPULAR VARIETY PLANTED FOR 1988

Highlights

Siouxland took over as the most popular winter wheat variety sown for the 1988 crop with 21.3% of Nebraska's acreage. Brule fell from first to second after three years at the top with 17.1%. Centura, Centurk (including Centurk 78), and Colt held the next three positions, similar to a year ago, with 11.9%, 9.8%, and 4.4%, respectively.

Siouxland was the leading variety in the North Central, Northeast, East Central, Southwest, and Southeast Districts. Brule was the most popular in the Central

and South Central Districts. The Northwest's most popular variety was Centura.

Data Source

The wheat variety data was provided through the response of many Nebraska wheat producers in our annual Fall Acreage and Production Survey. The wheat variety survey summary included 1,323 reports representing about nine percent of the State's total planted acreage estimate.
